PURPOSE/AIM OF THIS EMERGENCY PLAN

The purpose of this Emergency Plan is to give instructions for dealing with emergencies at SCM. These instructions must be followed by all personnel on Site when an emergency happens.

The Emergency Plan is prepared in accordance with:

- Good risk management practice;
- Relevant regulatory requirements of Workplace Health and Safety Legislation;
- Relevant regulatory requirements of Environmental Protection Legislation.

OBJECTIVES

The desired outcomes of the Emergency Plan are to:

- (a) Control or limit any effect that an emergency or potential emergency may have on or off Site;
- (b) Control and limit any environmental effect that an emergency or potential emergency may have on Site
- (c) facilitate emergency response and to provide such assistance on the Site as is appropriate to the situation;
- (d) ensure that all vital information is communicated to relevant and external agencies and surrounding businesses as soon as possible;
- (e) facilitate the reorganisation and recovery operations so that normal operations can be resumed;
- (f) provide relevant emergency training so that a high level of emergency preparedness can be continually maintained;
- (g) Provide a basis for the revision of emergency procedures.

WHAT IS AN EMERGENCY?

An emergency is any event that arises internally or from external sources, which may adversely affect the safety of persons on or around the Site, or adversely affect the environment and requires immediate response by the occupants.

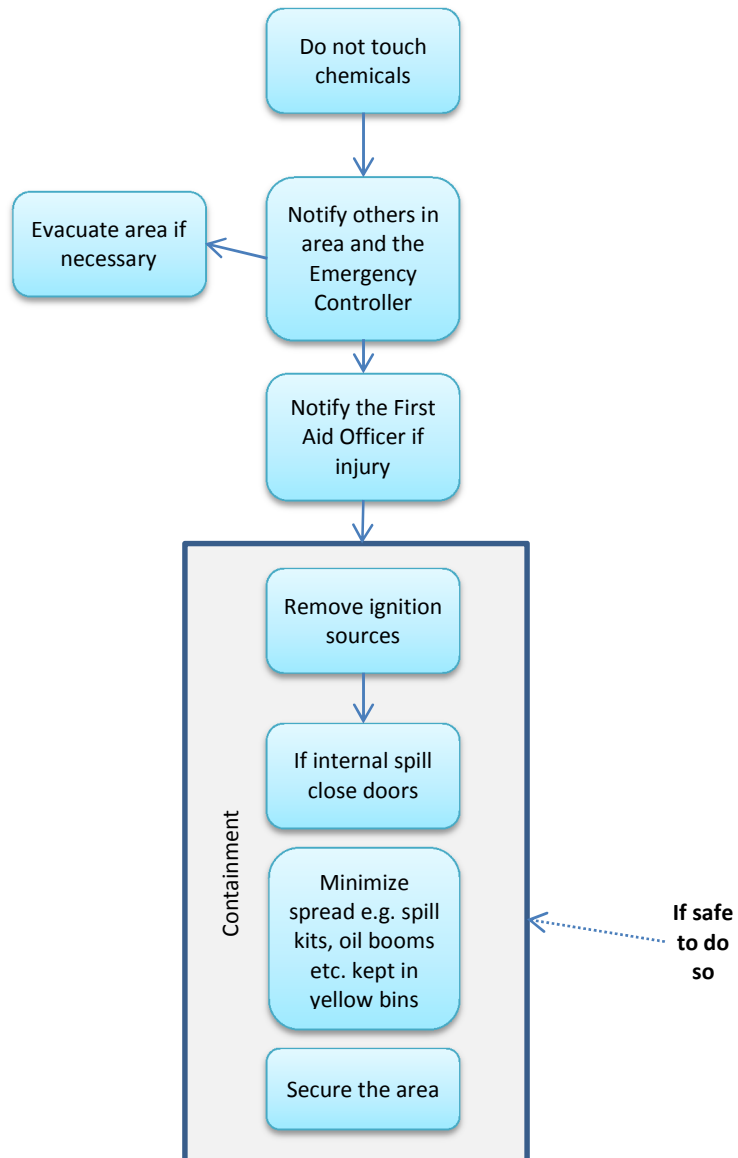
At SCM the main emergency events that are identified and provided for in this Emergency Plan are:

- **Fire**
- **Explosion**
- **Chemical spill or Environmental Incident**
- **Serious injury**
- **Severe storm**

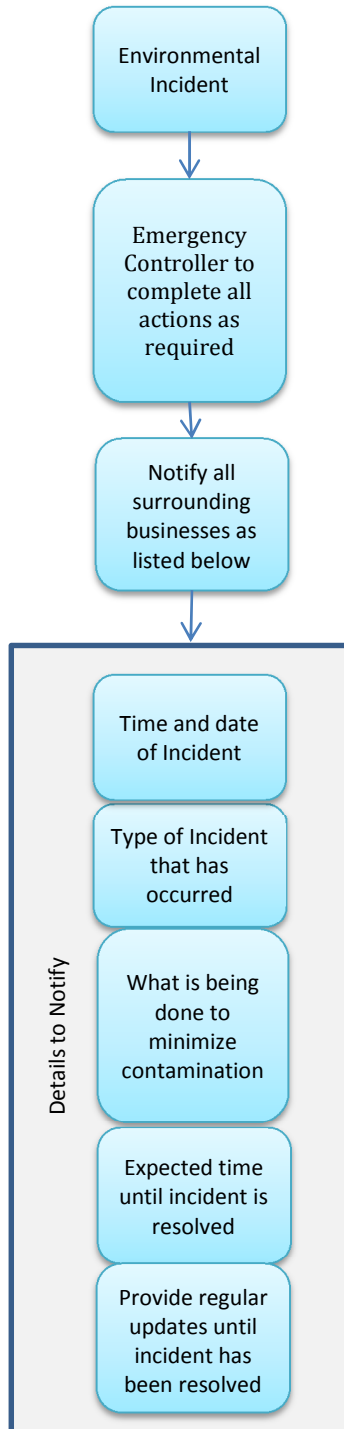
SCM has established 3 levels of emergency as follows:

- Level 1 (Low)** Event that results in minor injuries with low risk of continuing/ minor loss of integrity of access or assets / use of minimal emergency management / local or no evacuation / no residual threat of contamination of the environment.
- Level 2 (Serious)** Event that results in injury with possible injuries to others / actual or probable severe loss or use of major assets / incident requires deployment of significant Site resources and possible external resources / area evacuation with possible Site evacuation / actual or potential contamination of the environment.
- Level 3 (Major)** Event that results in serious injuries requiring hospital admission or death / high chance of continuing risk / major actual loss of assets / deployment of all resources including external / Site evacuation / contamination of the environment.
